### **General Instructions for Lions Contact Person!!!!**

Each testing unit should have instructions for each. Suggested practice time of at least 15 minutes prior to opening. Several pieces of the equipment may be in special cases. Please try to return them to their original case. Each test should take between 5 to 6 minutes, however the blood sugar may take longer, depending on the patient and the user of the equipment. Suggest a medical professional or a diabetic familiar with testing requirements. Setting up with two people may take about 20 minutes. Suggest-Tables are first to place, then chairs and equipment. Each device requires an electrical plug. Suggest cross training with adjacent volunteers, in case one needs to leave. Hearing test requires a quiet room or, if room is very large, a quiet corner. If insurance is requested by owner of event site, please contact Lion John Lyon and a form will be mailed. Suggest shifts of no more than 3 hours and an extra volunteer (floater) just in case. You need at least 5 volunteers to run the tests plus one floater, one for registration, and one to review the 3-part form at the end of testing with the Top copy going to them, second and third are ours. Please return those used forms. A Spanish speaker should be available is needed.

**Important** for all Lion volunteer to know that this is a screening not a diagnosing unit!!! Your reviewer, who gives the top copy to our customer, should remind our customer **THAT** and explain that physicians do the diagnosing. If customer have questions or have imperative problems refer them to a professional. Each county should have a Health Department if patient cannot afford a physician.
